Boas, salvage anthropology, historical particularism, cultural relativism, McIlwraith, family groups, settlement patterns, the potlatch, descent groups, *In Search of the Hamat'sa*

Week 4: Early Ethnology, Interior and Northern BC

transitional area, Teit, Morice, Jenness, problem of tribe, restricted wanderers, central based wanderers, bilateral families, Sekani culture, knowledge as technology

Week 5: Culture Contact and Colonialism

colonialism, agents of colonialism, small pox, maritime fur trade, inland fur trade, Hudson Bay Company, gold rushes, non-native settlement, native and non-native space, James Douglas, Douglas Treaties, Indian Act, *Potlatch* (film)
