**Symbols and Magic**

**Practitioners and Altered States of Consciousness**

*Holy Ghost People* (film), altered states of consciousness, meditation, trance, chanting, changes to body chemistry, sacred pain, drugs and their effects, role of altered states, Vodou, priests, shamans, peyote, Sekani spirit questing, mediums

**Healing and Death**

Illness, soul loss, spirit possession, object intrusion, intrusion by disease entity, violations of taboo, mental illness, *Healers of Ghana* (film), death, souls, ghosts, vampires, zombies, death rituals, the afterlife, disposal of the body

**Witchcraft**

Witch, witchcraft, Azande, Navajo, wizardry, sorcery, functions of witchcraft, witchcraze
