Week 7: Plains

Algonquians, Cree, Siouan Speakers, Sun Dance, treaties and reserves, bison/buffalo, horse days, dog days

Week 8-9: Northwest Coast

Strength of the River (film), salmon, potlatching, *Delgamuukw v. The Queen*

Week 9: Western Subarctic (Introduced)

Athapaskan languages, Tahltan peoples, Tahltan stories
